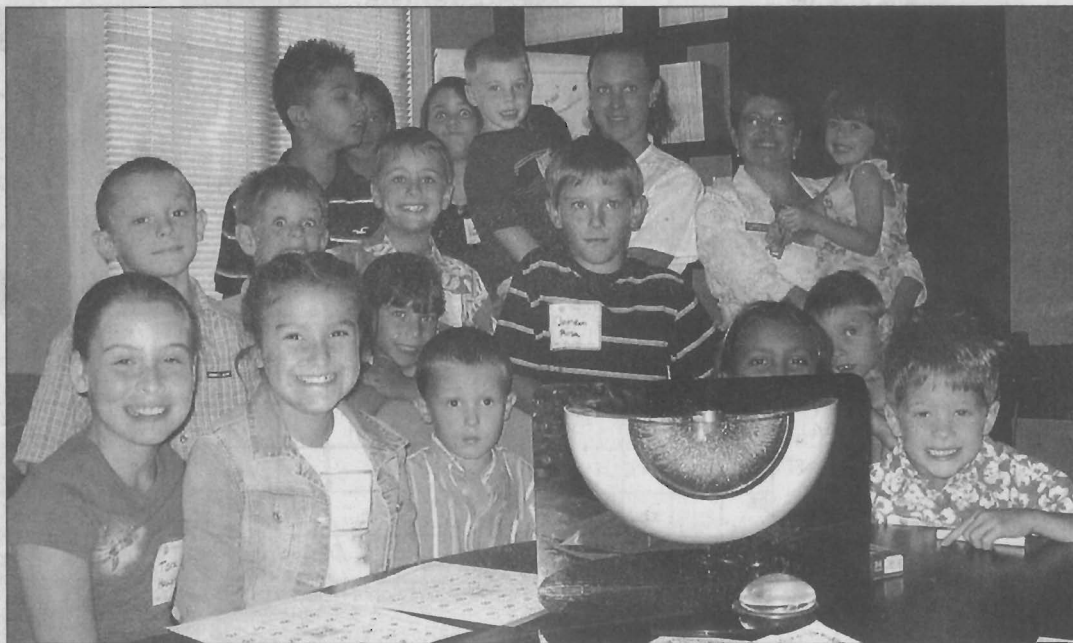


# Center for Sight celebrates 20 years with family day for employees
